<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science - Get Growing</u></p> <p>Try and grow something in your garden. It could be a flower, fruit or vegetable. Keep a diary and take photos to show how your plant grows.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science – Plant Hunt</u></p> <p>Go on a plant hunt in your garden. Try and identify some of the common wild and garden plants that you find. Can you find out if they come from a bulb or a seed? Photograph or draw the ones you find and write a caption about each one.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science – Animals</u></p> <p>Research common animals and create sets of animals that are mammals, fish, amphibians, reptiles and birds. Make a poster for each set, describing their main features, where they usually live, what they eat etc</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science – Humans</u></p> <p>Get an adult to help you draw around yourself on a piece of wallpaper or make a drawing of a person on a smaller piece of paper. Write labels for all the main parts of the human body and play a labelling game with them.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DT/Art</u></p> <p>Research handmade Easter cards online and then select one to make yourself at home. Perhaps yours could have a moving part or use a range of different materials. Think about who you are going to give your card to. Photograph it.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DT – Lego Challenge</u></p> <p>Take part in the 30-day Lego Challenge. Complete some of the tasks on the sheet and tick them off when you have made them.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DT/Art</u></p> <p>Design and make a hard-boiled egg character. Which character are you going to make and what materials could you use? Photograph your egg and write a description of your eggcellent character.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography - Weather</u></p> <p>Keep a weather diary over a week. Try and describe some of the main features of spring weather. Do you notice any changes to the length of the days?</p>
